- CBEST Test Preparation workshops to students

- Participated in Hispanic Heritage Month by hosting workshops for students
- Hosted “Future Teacher Week” with workshops and a Cal Poly, SLO campus tour

Highlights & Accomplishments

- Provided textbook vouchers worth \$250-\$500, as well as mileage reimbursement, to Cuesta College students who participated in project activities annually.
- Increased completion rates for degrees, certificates and transfer-readiness for teacher pathway students
- Created an academic and support structure for students, particularly Hispanic students, who pursued a teaching credential
- Created 5 Teacher Pathways
 - Created a new Elementary Teacher Education Program
 - Identified 23 Pre-teaching majors
 - Identified means of tracking students in pre-teaching majors
 - Created a ‘Get Focused, Stay Focused’ high school module for the teaching profession
 - Placed students in local K-12 classrooms for observations and experience
- Completed bilingual pathway information and Program Mapper for degree exploration
- Funded ubiquitous wireless access points
- Supported Latina Leadership Network and Educate Conference attendance
- Held Teaching Profession Information Sessions
- Held CBEST Test Preparation Workshops and provided CBEST testing (both face-to-face and distance)
