WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT/ CCAP?

Dual Enrollment is an opportunity for high school students to be enrolled with your high school and with Cuesta College at the same time! Enrollment fees are waived as a dual enrollment student with Cuesta College.

2 DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS AT CUESTA COLLEGE:

1. ENRICHMENT PROGRAM:

- Attend Cuesta College in person or online, outside of your high school day
- Enrollment fees are waived

2. COLLEGE AND CAREER ACCESS PATHWAYS (CCAP) PROGRAM:

- Attend Cuesta College during your regular high school day in your high school period
- Receive both high school and college credit for one high school period
- All student fees are waived (enrollment fees, campus fees, and all instructional materials including textbooks)

WHY PARTICIPATE IN COLLEGE AND CAREER ACCESS PATHWAYS (CCAP) WHILE IN HIGH SCHOOL?

- Complete high school and college credits at the same time in one high school period
- Save time and money
- Eases your transition to college in a supportive high school environment
 - *Most CCAP classes are taught by current high school teachers!
- Explore various careers and majors options before entering college





CCAP CLASSES OFFERED AT SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY HIGH SCHOOLS:

Over 70 unique Cuesta College courses are offered throughout SLO County High Schools, including courses to help students:

- Advance in their Career and Technical Education (CTE) Pathways
- Prepare for transfer to a university
- Assist students in achieving college and career readiness

DUAL ENROLLMENT/CCAP STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Students must follow through on the Enrollment Steps outlined for the course to receive college credit
- Students who participate in Dual Enrollment with Cuesta College will receive a grade on a high school transcript, and a Cuesta College transcript
- Students are also responsible for adhering to Cuesta College course-specific deadlines such as the Last Day to Drop from the Cuesta College course

STEPS TO ENROLL IN THE CCAP PROGRAM:

- Online Cuesta College Admissions Application
- One-Time CCAP Permit to Enroll
*High School Counselor, Principal, and Parent approval to participate is required
- Course-Specific Enrollment Form
